




Hi,

thank you for downloading Pixlie and give it a try.
Pixlie is easy to install.

Follow these easy steps:


Step 1: upload the folder “pixlie”

Upload the whole directory “pixlie” to your web server using FTP.



Step 2: change access permissions of folder cache to 777

Create a new folder cache inside the “pixlie” and change permissions to 777 (read / write / change for owner / group / all)



Step 3: Run it!

You should reach your Pixlie right now under www.yourdomain.com/pixlie/pixlie.php

Step 4: Upload images

Use your favourite FTP tool to upload the images into folders under “upload”. The gallery names are reflected by corresponding folder names. There are two limitations: First Pixlie supports only JPEG files with “.jpg” and “.jpeg” extension and second Pixlie does not support hierarchical galleries. A sample folder listing should look something similar like this:

Step 5: Change the design (for experienced users)

Pixlie uses a three layered logic reflected by three template files. These files are parsed and the #placeholder# placeholders get replaced.

Layer 1: Gallery root “uebersicht.html” is where all the galleries are listed

Layer 2: Galleries “galerie.html” is where all images of a specific gallery are listed

Layer 3: Image preview “bildvorschau.html” is a single image from one gallery

Step 6: Support Pixlie

It would be nice if you could include one of the Pixlie promotion buttons on your homepage. Several sizes and types can be found at <http://www.pixlie.de/promotion.html>

Troubleshooting:

Thumbs and preview images are rendered once at first access. That means if you change the picture or something went wrong they are not up to date. You can delete any contents of the cache folder at any time, as the smaller images are rendered again. If the gallery doesn't display at all, you probably have to modify the `pixlie.php`.
